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PROCEDURAL BACKGROUND

The Claimants and parties to these subcases represented by counsel filed a *Stipulation to Stay Litigation Schedule in Light of Lapse of Appropriations*. (Oct. 16, 2025) The *Stipulation* acknowledges that the federal appropriations act “that had been funding the Department of Justice expired and those appropriations to the Department lapsed.” It is unknown at the current time when such funding will be restored by Congress.

Based on these circumstances, counsel for the Department of Justice and counsel listed on the *Stipulation* ask for a stay of the September 18, 2025 litigation schedule, including deadlines.

The court concurs with the *Stipulation* in part, and hereby **vacates** the deadlines set in the September 18, 2025 **Order**.

The following deadlines are **vacated** and will be rescheduled as soon as possible.
